

- 1. One 30-centimeter ruler, or a ruler with centimeters on one side and inches on the other.
- **2. 5 unsharpened** No. 2 pencils with erasers; secure together with a rubber band.
- 3. 4 70-sheet notebooks of wide-or-college ruled paper, approximately 8"x10 1/2"; no loose-leaf paper

- **4. One** pencil sharpener
- **5. One** box of 16 or 24 crayons
- **6. One** pair blunt scissors (safety scissors with embedded steel blades work well)
- **7. One** 2 ½ " eraser
- **8. Five** black or blue ballpoint pens (**no gel ink**); secure together with a rubber band
