Operation Christmas Child

What is Operation Christmas Child?

The Samaritan's Purse project Operation Christmas Child collects shoeboxes—filled with school supplies, hygiene items, fun toys and notes of encouragement—and delivers them to children in need around the world to demonstrate God's love in a tangible way.

The Women of Zion have purchased 50 plastic shoebox size containers for the people of Zion to fill with Christmas gifts for children living in poverty overseas. These gifts not only bring hope they bring the Gospel of Jesus to each child through the Samaritan's Purse organization.

Please pick up an empty box (or two) and a "What to Pack" brochure located on the table under the youth board. (or you can use a regular shoebox or buy a container.

Each packed box must include \$9.00 cash or check made out to Samaritan's Purse placed inside the box for shipping.

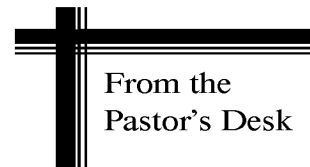

Thank you to all who helped in one way or another. You may have donated items to sell, carried in donations from cars, helped set up and price all of the many treasures, sold and packed on the days of the sale, brought in goodies for the workers, packed up the leftovers on Friday night and delivered them to Goodwill and Habitat for Humanity's Restore in Troy on Saturday morning.

WOMEN OF ZION – Sunday, Sept. 10, 2017

Jackie Glawe read devotions from "Our Daily Bread".

Treasurers Report was given by Sue Rambeau. She stated that approximately \$8,800.00 is in the womens' checking account.

Old Business: Heartfelt thanks was given to all those who helped organize the church picnic and worship at the Tipp City Park on Aug. 27.

New Business: Deb Keppel passed out neon colored flyers that could be taken to local businesses and displayed for the garage sale. Ruth will be calling for volunteers to work at the sale. Dec. 7 is the WOZ Christmas Dinner. Jill will contact the Troy H.S. Chorus to serve as our program.

Mission of the Month: Projects will be assigned to 2018 calendar at our October meeting.

Lutheran World Relief Fall Drop off for kits and quilts will be in Dayton on Oct. 6 & 7. Shipping costs were discussed: it costs \$1.40 for each School Kit and \$2.65 per Personal Care Kit, and \$2.25 per Mission Quilt. Motion was made, seconded, and carried that WOZ treasurer will write one check to Lutheran World Relief to cover the shipping costs of the kits and quilts. 15 women packed up dozens of school kits following the WOZ meeting.

WOZ purchased 50 plastic shoe boxes for the "Operation Christmas Child" mission of the month and will donate the balance needed to cover the shipping costs of the shoeboxes. Cost will be \$9.00 per shoe box. Blessing of the Quilts is Sept. 30 & Oct. 1.

Deb Turner had \$100 donated to the Good Samaritan Fund.

Ruth White recruited volunteers to provide meals for the Smith family on Tues. & Thurs. in September.
