

#### PROPERTY – August 2, 2021

July was a busy month for Zion building maintenance! The AC unit motor for the kitchen was replaced. The Hobart dishwasher was repaired. The switch assembly on the door was replaced and the vacuum breaker was leaking and was serviced. Detmer & Sons did a walk through the old building to consider options for replacing HVAC. S&G has finished staining and applying the protective sealer on the front entry doors on Main St. Willet Hauser Architectural Glass has given us quotes on repairing the stained glass windows throughout the building. The Fellowship Hall and hallway carpet was cleaned. The sacristy restroom toilet was adjusted and new faucets and supply lines were installed on the sacristy lavatory.

The monthly work list was completed including pews being moved back to the Fellowship hallway and the three keyboards moved into their customary locations.

5. Council approved the partnership of Bill Jones and Susie Gray as Zion's new choir directors starting in the fall 2021.

6. Council approved the planting of a tree in honor and memory of Terri Darrah the prior choir director. The blessing and tree planting ceremony will happen on Sunday September 19 at 2:00pm on the church's front lawn.
