

Lutheran World Relief School Kits



INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING IN EACH LWR SCHOOL KIT:

These kits will be shipped overseas to help children learn, in disadvantaged areas. Each school kit needs the following items:

- **One** 30-centimeter ruler, with centimeters on one side and inches on the other.
- **Five unsharpened No. 2** pencils with erasers; secured together with a rubber band.
- **Four** 70-sheet notebooks of wide ruled paper. No loose leaf paper.
- **One** pencil sharpener
- **One** box of 16 or 24 crayons
- **One** pair **blunt** scissors. (**no** pointed scissors).
- **One** 2 ½ " eraser
- **Five** black or blue ballpoint pens (no gel ink); secured together with a rubber band

Stop by the church doors on Walnut St. and pick up a *School backpack* to get started, and fill the School Kit with necessary items above. Any questions, ask

COMMITTEE REPORTS

CHURCH COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS June 14, 2022

1. Approved minutes and financials from May 10, 2022.
2. Ministry Site Profile completed and has been forwarded on to the synod for them to move it forward to the next step.
3. The campaign to retire the mortgage is in the planning stages and will be introduced in early July.
4. New Members of the Zion Church Family will be formally accepted as members during the July 3rd church service. A new member reception will follow the service.
5. The initial meeting of the Technology Team was held on June 13th. The team has already established a priority list of projects and will meet again on June 27th to move forward in addressing the immediate technology needs.
6. Finance & Stewardship will be planning and working on a Pay Off the Building Debt Campaign as we move forward.

May 10, 2022: Long Term Planning Committee (LTPC)

Linda Holt will chair the Call Committee. Someone from Council will need to be a member of this committee as well. This will need to be acted upon by Council. LTPC met with Jessica Dorn to discuss how the church could better support her efforts moving forward. Material was gathered by the LTPC to complete the Ministry Site Profile, in order to get it submitted to the Synod.

Treasurer's report: Received a check from the clothesline for Zion's work done there: \$589.44. Checks written to Jeremiah's Letter, \$300 and Ky Tornado Relief, \$606.

Approved a \$100 check to be sent to the Lunch On Us program.

114 pairs of socks were donated or purchased for "Socks for Seniors".

Relay for Life has surpassed the goal of \$5,000 to be given to the American Cancer Society.

Lutheran Disaster Response will be sent a check towards Ukraine donations.
