- We continue to sing new anthems from All Creation Sings (purple supplement). The choir has introduced several pieces. We will continue gradually incorporating some of the new hymnody (and texts) into the service.
 - a. On September 18, we sang #987 African American spiritual *Guide My Feet*. We will repeat that Sunday, October 23rd.
 - b. This summer we sang #1078 *There is a Longing in Our Hearts*. The choir will reintroduce that hymn on October 2nd, and the congregation will sing the refrain. Then, we will sing it again (sermon hymn) on October 16th.

- c. The choir sang #1043 *Spirit, Open My Heart* back in the fall of 2021. The congregation sang the hymn June 19th and will sing it again October 2nd.
- d. Hopefully, we are seeing a trend. Learning new hymns is not a one-time endeavor, but we like repetition! I like to sing new hymns 2-3 times so the melody and texts become more familiar. You may also notice (on occasion) I will play a prelude or postlude on a newer hymn tune. This is another part of the learning curve. As evidence the repetition does work, there is nothing more joyous than hearing our children sing parts of the liturgy *This is the Feast* (from memory) as I heard this past Sunday.
- 2. Are you interested in ringing bells? We are planning for a bell choir (6 ringers and an accompanist) on Reformation Sunday, October 30. We have two brand new bell pieces selected A Mighty Fortress which we heard featured at the Columbus Augsburg Fortress Music Clinic and a spiritual arranged by Sandra Eithun: In the Morning When I Rise (Give Me Jesus) Rehearsals will be during the day (a weekday morning). - 3. Feature on a new composer: Brenda Portman. During September, organ pieces by Brenda Portman were played. The tune Thaxted (*O God Beyond All Praising* ELW 880) was played September 11 for postlude; on September 18th, the bluesy and emotive Wayfaring Stranger (All Creation Sings #1050) was played for prelude; then, on September 25, the tune Candler (Come, O Thou Traveler Unknown) was featured. Portman was educated at Wheaton College, Northwestern, and the University of Cincinnati's College-Conservatory of Music. She currently plays at Hyde Park Community United Methodist Church in Cincinnati. She is also adjunct organ teacher at Xavier University, on top of accompanying choirs and playing for worship services. In addition to her organ compositions (1 volume published by Augsburg and five additional from Sacred Music Press), she also writes sacred choral and vocal pieces
- 4. Starting Reformation Sunday for 4 weeks, we are going to have an organ partita (multi-movement piece) played before the service. If you are interested in hearing those, starting October 30th, come to service by 9:50am. More information will be in the November newsletter about these partitas.

WORSHIP & MUSIC August 3, 2022

Worship and Music Committee met Wednesday August 3, 2022, at 6pm. Attending were Carla Frame, Susie Gray, Bill Jones, Deb Keppel, Kervyn Mach, Pastor Dale Schaefer, and Lori Sebastian. We began the meeting by singing All Creation Sings # 961 *Come to the Table*. We discussed Adena Brass coming in August 7th (thank you Linda Holt for coordinating!), worship service at the Roundhouse August 21st, and Sunday School beginning September 11.

Vocal Choir is gearing up for the season. Choir will begin practicing September 7th, with the first piece being sung September 11th. Bill Jones mentioned the choir would sing all but the last Sunday of the month, and take a rehearsal off the last Wednesday of the month. Bill and Susie have selected choir pieces for fall and winter, and they are working into 2023.

Lori recognized Bill for providing vocal and guitar special music in June. Bill will be leading the hymns at the worship service at the Roundhouse on guitar! We have a couple additional ideas for soloists for

this fall. And we are hopeful for 6 people to play bells for Reformation for a joyful arrangement of *A Mighty Fortress*.

We will change some canticles in the liturgy beginning in September. Altar Guild would like to have Communion every week beginning in October (COVID permitting). Lori is planning a more involved prelude (5-10 minutes prior to the service) beginning on Reformation Sunday, continuing on All Saints Sunday, and flowing through most of November until Advent begins. We are continuing to use "beloved hymns" from the May surveys, and those are sung heartily!

Pastor Dale thanked everyone for their efforts, and mentioned attendance seemed up for the summer. He also mentioned some upcoming dates he will have Kristin Zimmann fill in for him. There will be no communion on Sunday, September 4th.

Three of our musicians attended workshops and seminars this summer. Lori had everyone sing another hymn from the Augsburg Fortress clinic (All Creation Sings 1015 *As a Mother Comforts Her Child*) and then showed a jazzy gospel rendition of the Magnificat (ELW 882) that we can consider select verses for an advent response that was demonstrated at the Association of Lutheran Church Musicians Conference in Valparaiso (Lori attended that virtually). Bill and Susie also mentioned the musicianship of the singers during the open choral reading sessions at the Augsburg Clinic. Bill also found 2 pieces for the choir for the upcoming year.

Our next meeting will be held Wednesday, October 5th at 6pm.
